STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the provisions of Chapter 241 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, entitled "An Act to supply the town of Lisbon with pure water."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges which were

- 2 granted to the town of Lisbon by Chapter 241 of the Private
- 3 and Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred three, are
- 4 hereby extended for and during the period of two years from
- 5 the twenty-fourth day of March, in the year of our Lord
- 6 nineteen hundred nine, and all the rights, powers and privi-
- 7 leges that were granted by said act may and shall be exer-
- 8 cised in the same manner and for the same purpose as pro-
- 9 vided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect March 24th, nineteen 2 hundred nine.
