AN ACT to amend Chapter 393 of the private and special laws  
of 1907, relating to fishing in Sebago Lake.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. So much of Chapter 393 of the private and  
2 special laws of 1907 as prohibits fishing in Sebago lake for  
3 trout and landlocked salmon, in accordance with the general  
4 law of the State, during the month of September of each  
5 year, is hereby repealed.
