

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, to amend Chapter thirty-two of the Resolves of Nineteen Hundred and Five, relating to Dairying Interests of the State of Maine.

Resolved: That chapter thirty-two of the Resolves of 2 Nineteen Hundred and Five be and is hereby amended by 3 striking out the word "three" in the third line and inserting 4 the word "five," so that said chapter as amended shall read 5 as follows:

'Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated, to be 7 expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Agri-8 culture, the sum of five thousand dollars annually hereafter 9 for the purpose of improving and protecting the dairy interests of the State of Maine, by employing a dairy expert, 11 and suitable assistants, and paying such expenses in con-12 nection therewith as the Commissioner may approve.
