RESOLVE, for Extra Pay to the Maine Volunteers in War with Spain,

Resolved: That the sums of sixty-six dollars for the year 2 nineteen hundred and nine and sixty-six dollars for the year 3 nineteen hundred and ten, be and are hereby appropriated 4 for extra pay for the Maine Volunteers in War with Spain.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The above is for payment of bounty to the Maine Volunteers in war with Spain of which seven hundred and four dollars is now unpaid. It has been customary to appropriate one hundred and ten dollars for the two years to cover any claims that may be presented.
