IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Robbinston to erect and maintain a wharf into the tide waters of the St. Croix river in the town of Robbinston, county of Washington.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Robbinston is hereby authorized

- 2 to erect and maintain a wharf at Hunt's Point in the town
- 3 of Robbinston, county of Washington, thirty-five or forty
- 4 feet below low water mark.

Sect. 2. Said town is hereby authorized to levy and col-

- 2 lect such sums of money as may be necessary for the pur-
- 3 chase of land approaches to, and the erection and main-
- 4 tenance of said wharf.
