Eaton, chairman of the com3 mittee on appropriations and financial affairs, the sum of 4 forty-three dollars and sixteen cents to pay the expenses 5 of said committee on its visits of inspection to State insti6 tutions and general hospitals in the city of Portland and to 7 the Maine State Sanatorium in the town of Hebron.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Resolves and petitions having been referred to the committee on appropriations and financial affairs asking that appropriations be made in aid of institutions and hospitals in the city of Portland and the sanatorium at Hebron, the committee deemed it necessary to visit the same, and the within appropriation is for the purpose of paying its expenses.
