STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation for the purpose of obtaining information in regard to wild lands for the purposes of taxation.

Resolved, That the sum of four thousand dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and 3 nine and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and 4 ten, to be expended by the board of State assessors under 5 the direction of the governor and council, for the purpose 6 of employing a competent person or persons whose duty 7 it shall be to assist said board in verifying and perfecting, 8 so far as practicable, a proper description of each parcel 9 or tract of wild land, and the individual or corporate ownerses ship thereof, in townships not incorporated, in order that 11 such lands may be properly described for taxation purposes,



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The work provided for by this resolve is in continuation of work that has been carried on by the board of State assessors for several years past, and has proved to be of material value. An appropriation for the same has been made biennially.
