STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of navigation on Sebec Lake.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby 2 appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of 3 buoys and lights in Sebec Lake for the year nineteen hundred and nine; and the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby 5 appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of 6 buoys and lights in Sebec Lake for the year nineteen hundred and ten. All said money shall be expended under the 8 direction of the State Steamboat Inspectors, and any part of 9 the money hereby appropriated which shall be unexpended 10 at the end of the year nineteen hundred and ten shall revert 11 to the State.
