IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Pepperell Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Pep2 perell Trust Company, which were granted by Chapter fifty3 seven of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
4 three, and extended and amended by Chapter two hundred
5 eighty-one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun6 dred five, and extended by Chapter one hundred fifty-eight
7 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred seven,
8 are hereby extended for one year from the approval of this
9 act, and the persons named in said act and their associates

10 and successors shall have all the rights, powers and priv-11 ileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in 12 the same manner and for the same purpose as specified in 13 said act; provided, however, that said company shall actually 14 commence business as a trust company within said one year. .
