STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Paris, Oxford County,
Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and thirty-two
2 dollars and fifty cents be and is hereby appropriated to be
3 paid to the treasurer of the town of Paris for said town,
4 the same being for moneys paid by said town for the ex-
5 pense of support of Lena Merrill at the Maine Industrial
6 School for Girls. The said Lena Merrill having no pauper
7 settlement in any incorporated town in this State, but was,
8 at the time of her commitment, cared for by the town of
9 Paris, at the expense of the State.
