STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to provide antitoxin by the local boards of health for diphtheria and other contagious diseases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. To provide for the control of diphtheria and 2 other contagious diseases, local boards of health shall fur-3 nish antitoxin free to all indigent persons suffering from 4 such diseases, in such manner as the State board of health 5 may direct.

Sect. 2. The State board of health is instructed and di-2 rected to make contracts with reputable manufacturers for 3 the sale of antitoxin to the local boards of health in such 4 manner as is deemed best and most economical for the sev-

5 eral towns, and said State board may arrange several towns6 and plantations into groups for the purchase of antitoxin7 when it appears that such arrangement would be the best,8 most convenient and most economical for them.
