RESOLVE in favor of John M. Taylor.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred ninety-two dollars 2 be and hereby is appropriated to be paid John M. Taylor 3 of Cape Elizabeth for expense of clerk hire incurred by 4 him in performance of his duties as State inspector of 5 steam vessels during the years nineteen hundred seven and 6 nineteen hundred eight.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the performance of his duties the inspector of steam vessels is necessarily absent from his headquarters many days in succession, and the employment of a clerk is absolutely necessary. No appropriation was made for the purpose in 1907, and therefore there were no funds to pay the bill.
