STATE OF MAINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Saddleback stream, sometimes called Pease stream, in Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of section 2 of chapter 407 of the 2 private and special laws of 1903 as prohibits fishing in 3 Saddleback stream, sometimes called Pease stream, in the 4 county of Franklin, from the junction of the Sandy river 5 and said Saddleback, or Pease stream, so called, at Madrid 6 Village, to Orrin Hinckley's bridge, so called, a distance 7 of one mile, is hereby repealed.
