STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in the tributaries to Little Sebago Lake, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for fish-2 ing in the tributaries to Little Sebago lake, so called, in 3 the county of Cumberland, from September first of each 4 year to April first of the following year, during which close 5 time it shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill any 6 kind of fish in any of said tributaries.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in 3 the general law of the State for illegal fishing.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and 2 police judges and trial justices in their respective counties 3 shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction with the 4 supreme judicial and superior courts.

Sect. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
