IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Mu-2 tual Fire Insurance Company which were granted by chap-3 ter five hundred and thirty-four of the private and special 4 laws for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven and 5 extended by chapter seventy-one of the private and special 6 laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and again ex-7 tended by chapter two hundred and ninety of the private 8 and special laws of nineteen hundred and one, and again 9 extended by chapter ninety-two of the private and special 1c laws of nineteen hundred and three, and again extended by

11 chapter three hundred and nineteen of the private and 12 special laws of nineteen hundred and five and again ex-13 tended by chapter one hundred and eleven of the private 14 and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby 15 further extended for two years from the going into effect 16 of this act.
