AN ACT to amend Section eighty of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes of Maine, relating to State aid for academies.

Bc it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section eighty of chapter fifteen of the Re2 vised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 "thirty" in the third line and inserting in place thereof the
4 word "twenty-five;" also by striking out the word "sixty"
5 in the fifth line of said section and inserting in place thereof
6 the word "fifty," so that said section as amended shall reac
7 as follows:

'Section 80. No academy shall receive State aid under 9 section seventy-six unless the average attendance in said

10 academy for the year preceding, or for five years next pre11 ceding, shall exceed twenty-five students, and no academy
12 shall receive to exceed five hundred dollars unless the aver13 age attendance in said academy for the year preceding shall
14 exceed fifty students."
