AN ACT to enlarge the rights of the Alfred Embroidery Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:


Section 1. The Alfred Embroidery Company, a corpo-

- 2 ration existing under the general laws of the State of Maine,
- 3 is hereby authorized and empowered to carry on the fol-
- 4 lowing business in addition to those named in its certificate
- 5 of organization.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to make,

- 2 generate, sell, distribute and supply gas and electricity for
- 3 lighting, heating, manufacturing and mechanical purposes
- 4 in the town of Alfred with all the rights and powers and

- 5 subject to all the duties and liabilities of similar corporations
- 6 organized under the general laws of the State.
