AN ACT to extend the charter of the Gardiner Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Gar
diner Trust Company, located at Gardiner, Kennebec Coun
ty, Maine, which were granted by Chapter fifty-nine of the

Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five, ap
proved February 17, 1905, are hereby extended for one year,

from the approval of this act, and the persons named in said

act, their associates and successors shall have all the rights,

powers and privileges that were granted by said original

act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same

purposes as specified therein; provided, however, that said

company shall actually commence business as a trust com-
