## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 164 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, relating to fishing in the tributaries to China Lake.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 164 of the Private and Spe-

- 2 cial Laws of 1907 is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word "so called" in the second line the words "or its tribu-
- 4 taries," so that said section, as amended, shall read as fol-
- 5 lows:

'Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or

- 7 kill any kind of fish through the ice in China lake, so-called,
- 8 or its tributaries, in China and Vassalboro, in the County of
- 9 Kennebec, or in Lovejoy pond, so-called, in Albion, in said
- 10 County of Kennebec.'
