IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Dead Stream Pond, Lower Cold Stream Pond and Horseshoe Pond, in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of section 1 of chapter 407 of the Pri-2 vate and Special Laws of 1903, as amended, as prohibits fish-3 ing through the ice, in accordance with the general law of 4 the State, in Dead Stream pond, so called, and Lower Cold 5 Stream pond and Horseshoe pond, so-called, in Ten Thou-6 sand Acre Township, so-called, Somerset County, is hereby 7 repealed. **,** *
