## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 13 of Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter 75 of the Public Laws of 1905, relating to the snaring of rabbits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The last sentence of section 13 of chapter 32 2 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 75 of the 3 Public Laws of 1905, is hereby amended by striking out the 4 first nine words of said section, being the words "this sec-5 tion shall not apply to Hancock county, and," so that said 6 sentence, as amended, shall read as follows:

"In Oxford, Penobscot and Piscataquis counties it may and 8 shall be lawful to catch wild hares or rabbits in box traps." · · · · . . •
