House Amendment A to House Document No. 184.

Amend by adding the following sections:

- Sect. 3. The antitoxine shall be kept by the secretary
- 2 or chairman of the local board, and shall be furnished
- 3 physicians upon application on blanks provided and fur-
- 4 nished by the State Board.
- Sect. 4. The local board shall provide a repository for
- 2 antitoxine which may be furnished to any physician at the
- 3 same rates as furnished by the State Board of Health and
- 4 to their patients on prescription. The local board of health
- 5 in any town furnishing an indigent residing in another town
- 6 antitoxine upon application, as above provided, shall be
- 7 reimbursed by the town where the patient resides. The
- 8 State shall reimburse cities or towns furnishing antitoxine
- 9 to any person having no legal residence in any city or town
- 10 within the State.
