IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

---

AN ACT to regulate the catching of pickerel in Lake Pushaw.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sect. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take,  
2 catch or kill in Lake Pushaw and its tributaries, located west  
3 of Old Town in Penobscot County, more than ten pounds  
4 of pickerel in any one day; and no person shall otherwise  
5 dispose of said pickerel so caught, than to convey them to  
6 his own home for consumption therein.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this  
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten or more  
3 than thirty dollars for each offence.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, municipi-  
2 pal and police courts and trial justices within their respective  
3 counties shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction, upon  
4 complaint, with the supreme and superior courts.
