AN ACT to revive and extend the charter of the Skowhegan Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Skow
hegan Trust Company, which were granted by Chapter four

hundred and seventy-eight of the Private and Special Laws

of nineteen hundred and one, are hereby revived and ex
tended for one year; and the persons named in said act, their

associates and successors shall have all the rights, powers and

privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised

in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified

in said act; provided, however, that said company shall ac
tually commence business as a trust company within said one
