STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT prohibiting the throwing of sawdust and other waste material into Highland Lake, or any of its tributaries in the city of Westbrook, towns of Windham, Gray and Falmouth, and into Mill Brook in Westbrook, all in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall cast or throw into Highland
2 Lake or any of its tributaries in the city of Westbrook and
3 towns of Windham, Gray and Falmouth, or into Mill Brook
4 in Westbrook, all in the County of Cumberland, any sawdust,
5 shavings, bark or other mill waste or refuse of any kind, or
6 place or deposit such sawdust, shavings, bark or other mill

7 waste or refuse of any kind along the banks of said waters
8 in such manner that the same shall fall or be washed into
9 said brook or lake.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five nor more
3 than fifty dollars and costs for each offence.
