STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of aid in repairing highway in the town of Greenbush.

Resolved, That the sum of twelve hundred dollars be paid 2 six hundred dollars in the year nineteen hundred and nine, 3 and six hundred dollars in the year nineteen hundred and 4 ten, be and hereby is appropriated from any unexpended 5 moneys in the treasury to aid in repairing said highway in 6 said town a distance of about four miles, which is included in 7 this distance three or four sand hills.

Provided, that a sum of money be raised by said town or 9 otherwise, which, together with the amount herein appropriated, shall be sufficient to repair and complete said high-11 way within two years from the date of the approval of this
12 resolve without further aid from the State. Said road shall be under the supervision of State Highway 14 Commissioner. All moneys under this resolve shall be paid 15 upon vouchers satisfactory to the governor and council. Said 16 repairs to be made and completed during the years nineteen 17 hundred nine and nineteen hundred ten.
