## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Trescott.

*Resolved*, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and is 2 hereby appropriated; two hundred and fifty dollars for the 3 year nineteen hundred and nine and two hundred and fifty 4 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, to the town 5 of Trescott in maintaining its roads and bridges, said sums 6 to be expended under the direction of the county commis-7 sioners of Washington County.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Trescott is located in the eastern part of Washington County, and its principal industry is farming. There is no store located within the limits of the town nor any manufacturing whatsoever. There are forty miles of public highways to maintain and twelve bridges averaging from ten to thirty feet from approach to approach. The valuation of the town is \$56,-000, and the rate of taxation is thirty-five mills. There is outstanding in notes and other indebtedness the amount of about twenty-five hundred dollars.
