STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of East Machias.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred forty-seven dollars 2 and sixty-five cents be appropriated to reimburse the town 3 of East Machias for money expended in furnishing pauper 4 supplies to Stephen R. Fenlason, a State pauper.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

A bill for two hundred twenty-one dollars and forty cents paid for pauper supplies furnished to one Stephen R. Fenlason, a State pauper, was submitted to the Governor and Council by the Overseers of the Poor of the town of East Machias for payment.

Of this amount one hundred seven dollars and seventy-five cents was approved for payment by Charles D. Newell, of the Governor's Council, Jan. 1, 1909.

One hundred forty-seven dollars and sixty-five cents being disallowed by the Governor and Council on technical grounds. This resolve is to reimburse the town for the latter amount.
