AN ACT relating to an open season for the hunting of certain game birds in the County of Hancock.


Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section I of Chapter 281 of the Private and

- 2 Special Laws of 1907 is hereby amended by striking out the
- 3 word "September" in the third line thereof and inserting the
- 4 word "November," in its place, and by striking out the word
- 5 "February" in the third line thereof and inserting the word
- 6 "April" in its place so that said section 1, as amended, will
- 7 read as follows:

'Section 1. It shall be lawful to hunt, chase, catch and

- o kill the game bird known as golden eye or whistler in the
- 10 County of Hancock from November first to the first day of
- 11 April of the following year.'
