Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum 2 of six thousand dollars in aid of a bridge across the Aroos-3 took River at the Cameron Crossing, so-called, in the town 4 of Masardis in Aroostook County, said sum to be disposed 5 of under the direction of the selectmen of said town of 6 Masardis, provided it does not exceed two-thirds the cost of 7 the bridge.
