Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be appro-2 priated for the year 1909, and two hundred dollars for the 3 year 1910, to aid in carrying out the purposes of said Mis-4 sion; and to aid in the support of aged and infirm deaf of 5 the State. f

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There are in this State several aged and infirm deaf persons who could not be well provided for by the various cities or towns in which they have a residence, and this resolve is to aid the Mission in caring for as many as possible of the worthy aged and infirm persons in the New England Home for the Deaf, or in such places as are adapted to their needs.
