HOUSE AMENDMENT A to House Document 220.

House Document No. 220 is hereby amended by striking 2 out the word "hold" in the fourth line of Section 3, and all 3 lines there following in the said section, and inserting in lieu 4 thereof the following words: "be plainly stamped agreeably 5 to the standard mentioned in Section 2 of said bill, with 6 figures indicating the quantity which such measures, cans 7 or other vessels hold," so that said section when amended 8 shall read as follows:

'Section 3. When milk or cream is purchased by measure 10 at wholesale by any person, firm or corporation engaged in 11 the business of buying or selling milk or cream or both, the 12 can or other vessel containing such milk or cream shall be

- 13 plainly stamped agreeably to the standard mentioned in Sec-
- 14 tion 2 of said bill, with figures indicating the quantity which
- 15 such measures, cans or other vessels hold.
