STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit expectoration in certain Public places and Conveyances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall expectorate or spit on any pub2 lic sidewalk, or public street crossing, or cross walk, or, ex3 cept in receptacles provided for the purpose, upon the floor
4 in any city or town hall, in any court house or court room, in
5 any factory, in any public library or museum, in any church
6 or theatre, in any lecture or music hall, in any ferryboat or
7 steamboat, in any railroad car, except a smoking car, in any
8 street or interurban railway car, in any railroad or railway
9 car, in any railroad or railway station, or waiting room or
10 on any sidewalk or platform connected therewith.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be punished by a fine of not more than twenty dollars.
