STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of repairing the road between Seboomook and Pittston Farm.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to aid in repairing 3 the road leading from Seboomook, in Somerset County, to 4 Pittston Farm. The sum to be expended upon that portion 5 of the road which lies between Seboomook, so-called and 6 Pittston Farm. The sum to be expended under the direction 7 of an agent to be appointed for that purpose by the Gover-8 nor and Council.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road has been a thoroughfare for lumber operations for more than half a century, and great quantities of freight and supplies are hauled over it every year. Sportsmen and tourists pass over it in large number. It is a bad state of affairs and is not safe or convenient for travellers. The State assisted in repairing part of the road two years ago.
