RESOLVE, in favor of Lincoln Academy.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to be
2 paid to the trustees of Lincoln Academy for the use and
3 benefit of that institution for the year nineteen hundred and
4 nine the sum of five hundred dollars, and for the year nine-
5 teen hundred and ten the sum of five hundred dollars; the
6 same to be expended for necessary repairs upon the build-
7 ings of said institution.
