IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize and empower Leone R. Cook and others, trustees, to convey certain interests in real estate to the inhabitants of the Town of Yarmouth.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Leone R. Cook, Ferdinand B. Merrill, Frederic 2 E. Gore and William M. Bradley, trustees under the will of 3 George W. Hammond, are authorized and empowered to

- 4 convey all their interest as such trustees in and to the "Old
- 5 Baptist Meeting House Property," so called, and the "Buck-
- 6 nam lot," so called, each situated in Yarmouth, to the In-
- 7 habitants of the Town of Yarmouth, for the purpose of a
- 8 town hall.

Sect. 2. Leone R. Cook, Ferdinand B. Merrill, Frederic E. 2 Gore and William M. Bradley, trustees under the will of 3 Ellen S. S. Hammond, are authorized and empowered to 4 convey all their interest as such trustees in and to the "Old 5 Baptist Meeting House Property," so called, situated in 6 Yarmouth, to the Inhabitants of the Town of Yarmouth for 7 the purpose of a town hall.
