IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend and amend the charter of the Cornish, Water, Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Corn2 ish Water, Light and Power Company which were granted
3 by chapter three hundred and ten of the Private and Special
4 Laws of one thousand nine hundred and seven are hereby
5 extended for two years from the date of the approval of this
6 act; and the persons named in this act, subject to section
7 two of this act, their associates and successors, shall have all
8 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by
9 said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same
10 purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. Said act is hereby amended by striking out in the 2 fourth line thereof the words "Frank G. Day, Bradley Al-3 len."
