IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section I of Chapter 61 of the Special Laws of 1907 relating to the lobster industry within two miles of the shore of Monhegan Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 61 of the Private and 2 Special Laws of 1907 is hereby amended by striking out 3 from said section the words "first day of June and the 4 twenty-fifth of November of each and every year," and 5 inserting in lieu thereof the following: 'twenty-fifth day 6 of June of each year and the fifteenth of January follow-7 ing,' so that said section when amended shall read as fol-

8 lows:

'Section I. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill, destroy IC or set any lobster trap or other device for the purpose of II taking, catching, killing or destroying any lobster or lob-12 sters within two miles of the shore of Monhegan Island I3 between the twenty-fifth day of June of each year and the I4 fifteenth of January following.'
