
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Belgrade stream, in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section I. It shall be lawful to fish in Belgrade stream,
- 2 so called, from Snow pond to Wing's Mill dam, so called,
- 3 on said stream, under the same restrictions as apply to fish-
- 4 ing in the Belgrade chain of lakes.
- Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
