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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE, in favor of Donald M. Hastings of Bristol, Me.,  
Co. E, 4th Maine Inf., 1861.

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*Resolved,* That there be paid to Donald M. Hastings of  
2 Bristol a pension of six dollars per month, commencing the  
3 first day of January, nineteen hundred and nine, and con-  
4 tinuing until his death or until repealed by the legislature.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Reports certify that he enlisted for the State April 27, 1861. Served for State until June 15, 1861, mustered in U. S. service June 15, 1861. Left on field sick in Rockland, Me., July 17, 1861. Measles had previously broken out in camp and he was one of the last to take the disease and in consequence lost the sight of left eye. He was honorably discharged but lost certificate of same in a fire in his hotel in Boise City. Is now 67 years of age, poor and unable to perform manual labor.
