STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine, relating to jail sentence for maintaining a liquor nuisance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter twenty-two of the Re-2 vised Statutes of the year of our Lord one thousand nine 3 hundred and three is hereby amended by inserting after

- 4 "and" in the first line the words 'less than one hundred dol-
- 5 lars and." Said section is further amended by striking out
- 6 the word "or" in the second line and inserting in its place
- 7 the word 'and.' Said section is further amended by in-

8 serting after the word "not" in the second line the words
9 'less than thirty days and not,' so that said section as
10 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 2. Whoever keeps or maintains such nuisance, 12 shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars and not ex13 ceeding one thousand dollars, and imprisonment in jail not 14 less than thirty days and not more than one year.'
