STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, as amended, relating to fishing in Hayden Lake, so-called, in the town of Madison, in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. It shall be lawful to fish through the ice, in accordance with the general law of the State, in Hayden lake, so-called, in the town of Madison, in Somerset county, from daylight to sunset on Saturday of each week. So much of section I of chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903 as is inconsistent with this act is hereby repealed.
