## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Paragraph twenty of Section one of Chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and three as amended by Chapter one hundred and twenty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five, relating to Sea and Shore Fisheries.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph twenty of section one of chapter
- 2 one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes of nineteen
- 3 hundred and three, as amended by chapter one hundred and
- 4 twenty of the public laws of nineteen hundred and five, is
- 5 hereby further amended by striking out the words "fifteen
- 6 hundred" in the first line, and inserting in place thereof the

7 words 'two thousand,' so that said paragraph when amend-8 ed will read as follows:

'Commissioner of sea and shore fisheries, two thousand dol-10 lars and actual travelling expenses.'
