RESOLVE authorizing the land agent to make a deed for the purpose of curing defects in the title to Dog Fish Island in the Penobscot Bay.

Resolved, That the State Lang Agent be, and he is hereby a authorized and empowered, upon payment of nominal consideration of one dollar, to make, execute and deliver to Lloyd H. Mills, his heirs and assigns, all the right, title and interest which the State of Maine has in and to Dog Fish Island, located in Penobscot Bay near the western entrance to Fox Island Thoroughfare, together with the adjacent, connected and outlying rocks and reefs to low water mark.
