AN ACT to regulate fishing in Taylor Pond, in Auburn,  
Androscoggin County

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kill any kind of fish at any time on or through the ice in  
3 Taylor pond, so called, in Auburn, in Androscoggin county,  
4 under the same penalty as is provided in the general law  
5 of the State for the illegal fishing for and catching trout  
6 and landlocked salmon.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and  
2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-  
3 ties shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent  
4 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and all

5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of this  
6 act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same  
7 to the State Treasurer, and credited to fines and license fees  
8 for the protection of birds and game.
