STAFE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Rome.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty dollars be and hereby 2 is appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town 3 of Rome for money paid by said town for tuition of a pupil 4 at the Maine Wesleyan Seminary, same being one-half the 5 amount actually paid by said town.
