IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the time in which the Van Buren Sewerage Company is authorized to organize and commence business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Chapter one hundred and eighty-two of the 2 private and special laws of the year nineteen hundred and 3 three, continued in force by virtue of chapter one hundred 4 and sixteen of the private and special laws of the year nine-5 teen hundred and five, and further continued in force by 6 virtue of chapter four hundred and nine of the private and 7 special laws of the year nineteen hundred and seven, is here-8 by continued in force, and the corporators named therein 9 are hereby given a further period of two years from the 10 date of the approval of this act in which to organize and 11 commence business under said act. •
