IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relating to the Richmond Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Richmond Electric Company, a corpora-

- 2 tion organized under the general laws of the State of Maine,
- 3 is hereby authorized to make, generate, sell, distribute, and
- 4 supply electricity for lighting, heating, power or mechanical
- 5 purposes, in the towns of Richmond and Bowdoinham,
- 6 county of Sagadahoc and State of Maine.
 - Sect. 2. For the purposes mentioned in section one, said
- 2 company is hereby authorized and empowered to build, erect,
- 3 and operate manufactories and works, for making, generat-
- 4 ing, distributing and supplying electricity upon said property,

5 to use the same therein, and to erect, lay down, contract, 6 maintain and operate lines of wires or other material for the 7 transmission of electricity under, along, upon and over the 8 streets, ways and bridges in said Richmond and Bowdoin-9 ham, subject to the restrictions and regulations regarding the 10 same, as provided in Revised Statutes, chapter 55, sections 16 11 to 24 inclusive.
