STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of the navigation of the Lower Lakes.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars is hereby 2 appropriated for the placing of buoys in the Lower Lakes, 3 so called, to wit: North Twin Lake, North Twin Thorough-4 fare, South Twin Lake, South Twin Thoroughfare, Pema-5 dumcook Lake, Pemadumcook Thoroughfare, Ambegigus 6 Lake, and Ambegigus Thoroughfare, and for the mainte-7 nance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and nine, 8 and the sum of five hundred dollars is hereby appropriated 9 for the placing of buoys in said Lower Lakes and for the 10 maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and 11 ten. Said buoys shall be placed at said points in said lakes 12 and thoroughfares as will best serve the needs of navigation 13 thereon. All said monies shall be expended under the

14 direction of the State Steamboat Inspectors; any part of 15 the money hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys 16 and maintenance thereof which shall be unexpended at the 17 end of the year nineteen hundred and ten shall revert back 18 to the State.
