STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize and empower Joseph Dresser to remove the remains of certain deceased persons from his farm in Cape Elizabeth to the public cemetery.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Joseph Dresser of Portland in the County of 2 Cumberland is hereby authorized and empowered to remove 3 or cause to be removed by some suitable person the bodies 4 and remains of all deceased persons buried on the farm for-5 merly owned and occupied by him in Cape Elizabeth in said 6 County of Cumberland, and all headstones and markers at 7 the graves of such deceased persons, and decently inter said 8 bodies and remains and properly reset such headstones and 9 markers over such bodies and remains in the public ceme-10 tery in said town of Cape Elizabeth. .
